THIS MOUSE AND HER UNBORN PUPS REDUCED THE ZIKA VIRUS LOAD BOTH IN MATERNAL AND FETAL TISSUES, AND THE PUPS WERE PROTECTED AGAINST FETAL DEATH.

A team of researchers from Imperial College London and Washington University in St. Louis (USA) has shown that antibodies from human patients infected with Dengue virus can be effective in the treatment of Zika infection in mice.
